Casey Iames, NRCS District Conservationist (written report submitted)

Ms. Iames states that NRCS has just announced funding to support producers transitioning to organic production by providing financial assistance (FA) and technical assistance (TA) to implement conservation practices that support organic production. The OTI supports USDA's objective of developing diverse and equitable food systems while encouraging climate-smart agriculture by focusing funds on transitioning producers to organic production. Virginia's OTI Application Deadline is close of business (COB) June 15, 2023. The ranking deadline will be COB 7/28/23. See attached for Ms. Iames's complete report.

Education Programs Update - Kim Lowther

Ms. Lowther stated that registrations are being received for Farm Field Days. Fifteen schools have applied. She visited John Marshall's Farm Field Days event on May 17th. It is a smaller venue than Prince William with 37 students in attendance. Ms. Lowther will attend two MWEE events next week; Marumsco Hills Elementary School and Dale City Elementary School to assist with their macro invertebrate studies.

The volunteer awards ceremony will be held at Windy Knoll Farm on Tuesday, June 13, 2023 from 6 – 8 p.m.

Water Quality Programs Update - Veronica Tangiri

The sculpture ceremony is scheduled for Thursday, May 25, 2023 at Freedom High School. Supervisor Boddye is scheduled to attend. The District will establish a partnership with The Center for Environmental and Natural Sciences at Freedom High School to store the sculpture and to promote Water Quality Awareness, especially around plastic pollution. The sculpture was funded by a grant in the amount of \$15,000 from the Community Foundation for Northern Virginia. It was created by Angela Pozzi, CEO/Creative Director/Artist from ReUPit. VCAP Update – Nicole Slazinski

Ms. Slazinski stated that several individuals have contacted her for information on the VCAP program, however, we have not received any new applications to date. One individual has completed his VCAP project but has not contacted her to verify the date. She plans to follow up with him. She has posted a sample application on the pwswcd.org website to assist applicants in completing the form.

VACS Update - Duane Mohr

Mr. Mohr stated that 4 cost share plans were approved at the TRC meeting today, May 18, 2023. To date, approximately \$200,000 has been allotted. We need to secure \$270,000 in cost share plans to maintain our TA. We are currently working on two additional projects. Two 2021 projects have been cancelled – Jay Yankey and Thomas Latham. We are attempting to close out two 2020 projects.
